The end of all things is near. Therefore be alert and of sober mind so that you may pray. Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins. Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling. Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. If anyone speaks, they should do so as one who speaks the very words of God. If anyone serves, they should do so with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen. 1 Peter 4:7-11

In Verse 7 Peter says that the end of all things is near. He is simply saying that as believers we don't have any time to waste. We can't see what is ahead—we don't know what tomorrow holds. But we do know that our Great God is in control! Since that is true we should keep doing three things.

**First he says we should keep on praying.** "Therefore be alert and of sober mind so that you may pray." We all know prayer is both the responsibility and privilege of all Christians. We get to enter the presence of the living God, we get to offer praises for who He is and all He has done, we get to lay ourselves open to Him to receive forgiveness, comfort and strength. We get to share our requests and know that our God hears and answers. Peter says the best way to do this is to be alert and sober of mind. So, we are to come into the presence of God thinking clearly and with a calm spirit, because He is in control.

Next Peter says keep on loving. "Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins. Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling." That word deeply in the original language means literally to "Stretch out". It is the idea of straining to reach the goal. In other words, when it comes to love, give it everything you've got—love like everything depends on it. He says love does two things—it covers a multitude of sin. That means it helps us forgive the faults of others. And love is practical—it offers hospitality. Love reaches out to help others without complaining.

**Finally Peter says keep on serving.** "Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. If anyone speaks, they should do so as one who speaks the very words of God. If anyone serves, they should do so with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen." We have all been given a spiritual gift as believers to be used to build up the body of Christ and bring honor to God. Your gift may be some kind of speaking gift or a gift of practical service. Regardless of the nature of the gift, the purpose is-- that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever.

In light of all that we have been through in these past weeks I find Peter's words to be very encouraging—Keep on praying, keep on loving, keep on serving. Amen! **Blessings, Steve**


