Listen to what Paul says in Ephesians 4:1-6 Therefore I, a prisoner for serving the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God.² Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love.³ Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace. ⁴ For there is one body and one Spirit, just as you have been called to one glorious hope for the future.

How can we be proactive in promoting unity in the Body? Let me give you three suggestions:



We are collecting bars of soap for Red Box Ministries which collects items and distributes to the female inmate population of NC. CHRISTMAS BACKPACK ~ Appalachian Ministries

What a great way to give locally! Please pack your backpack and bring to Lisa by **October 9th**, so that we may get them to Red Springs early. You have **one** week. Here is everything you will need:

- 1) **COLLECT ITEMS AND PREPARE BACKPACKS** to be taken to a regional distribution center. We encourage churches to begin collecting and filling the packs early and throughout the year. Each zippered school backpack should include:
- A) Small items of NEW items of warm clothing such as winter hats, gloves, socks, scarves, etc.
- B) Small pop-top canned food such as ravioli, tuna, beef stew, vegetables, fruit (3-4 cans)
- **C)** At least 1-2 **NEW, age appropriate non-breakable toy** (*no toy weapons, please!*) This can include small cars, balls, dolls, small stuffed animals, yo-yos, jump rope, sidewalk chalk, card games, Legos, etc. For oldest age group (15-17) substitute an appropriate item instead of a toy, such as, a flashlight, small thermos, light blanket, books, hunting/fishing magazines for the boys jewelry, books, skin care products, hair accessories, etc. for girls.
- **D)** Hygiene items including full sized containers of toothpaste, body wash, shampoo, and deodorant, as well as toothbrush, soap, washcloth, brush or comb. (*Please fit these items into a one gallon Ziploc bag so they do not leak out into the rest of the backpack*).
- **E)** Fresh, wrapped candy (no chocolate please, as it may melt; and no peanut products)
- **F)** A children's **Bible** or youth Bible (*no one version is required*) Please make sure that every pack has a Bible in it! **G)** A copy of "The Christmas Story" **
- **We ask that you enclose a copy of the Christmas story in each bag. You can download and print a .pdf copy of it here from our website (see link above). Printing Tip: If the second page prints out upside down, choose "short edge top" binding option under your printing preferences. You may have to click "Print using system dialog" to get to your advanced preferences. Packing hint: The Bible and Christmas Story flyer seem to fit best in the front pocket of the backpack.

Age Grouping and Labeling. Each backpack should be labeled boy or girl as well as the appropriate age. Age groupings for this year are **4-7**, **8-10**, **11-14**, **15-17**. Due to labels falling off in previous years, we went to a ribbon system for labeling last year, and it proved to be very effective. Each backpack will have two 10 inch ribbons tied to them - one to indicate gender and one for age, as follows:

Gender:

Blue ribbon will indicate a boy's backpack.

Pink Ribbon will indicate a girl's backpack.


Yellow ribbon will indicate that the backpack is for ages 4-7

Green ribbon for ages 8-10 Red ribbon for ages 11-14

White ribbon for ages 15-17.

Beware of wolves in sheep's clothing. Beware of this book! Oprah is pushing it. It is scary that someone would be bold enough to write a book from God's point of view contrary to His Word. This is in opposition of all faiths.

Schools are distributing this book to children through the Scholastic Book Club!!

The name of the book is Conversations with God. James Dobson talked about this book twice this week. It is devastating. Parents, churches and Christian schools need to be aware of it. Please pass this information on to church/e-mail addresses, Parents, Grandparents, Aunts, Uncles, Cousins, friends.

The books are, Conversations with God and Conversations with God for Teens, written by Neale D. Walsch. They sound harmless enough by their titles alone. The books have been on the New York Times best sellers list for a number of weeks, and they make truth of the statement, "Don't judge a book by its cover or title."

The author purports to answer various questions asked by kids using the "voice of God". However, the "answers" that he gives are not Bible-based and go against the very infallible word of God. For instance (and I paraphrase), when a girl asks the question "Why am I a lesbian?" His answer is that she was 'born that way' because of genetics (just as you were born right-handed, with brown eyes, etc.). Then he tells her to go out and "celebrate" her differences.

Another girl poses the question "I am living with my boyfriend. My parents say that I should marry him because I am living in sin. Should I marry him?" His reply is, "Who are you sinning against? Not me, because you have done nothing wrong."

Another question asks about God's forgiveness of sin. His reply "I do not forgive anyone because there is nothing to forgive... There is no such thing as right or wrong and that is what I have been trying to tell everyone, do not judge people. People have chosen to judge one another and this is wrong, because the rule is "'judge not lest ye be judged."

Not only are these books the false doctrine of the devil, but in some instances quote (in error) the Word of God.

And the list goes on. These books (and others like it) are being sold to school children through The Scholastic Book Club and we need to be aware of what is being fed to our children.

Our children are under attack. So I pray that you be sober and vigilant about teaching your children the Word of God, and guarding their exposure to worldly mediums, because our adversary, the devil, roams about as a roaring lion seeking whom he may devour (1 Peter 5:8). We know that lions usually hunt for the slowest, weakest and YOUNGEST of its prey.
